## Charter of the Club "Best of the Best"

### 1. General Provisions

1.1. The international club "Best of the Best" (hereinafter referred to as the Club) is a voluntary association of professionals, entrepreneurs, and creative individuals aimed at uniting talents in various fields.

1.2. The Club is a non-profit organization.

1.3. The Club carries out its activities on the principles of equality, mutual respect, support, and cooperation.

1.4. The Club operates on the basis of this Charter.

### 2. Goals and Objectives of the Club

2.1. Uniting outstanding professionals from different countries and fields of activity.

2.2. Development of international cooperation, joint projects, and cultural exchange.

2.3. Organization of joint events, travels, forums, and conferences.

2.4. Supporting talented individuals in creativity, science, and business.

2.5. Participation in charity and social projects.

2.6. Creation of international collaborations and partner communities.

### 3. Membership in the Club

3.1. Membership in the Club is voluntary. Any person over the age of 18 who shares the Club's goals and values may become a member.

3.2. Members of the Club may be individuals as well as legal entities (companies, organizations).

#### 3.3. Rights of members of the Club:

- Participation in the Club's events and projects;
- Use of the Club's resources for joint initiatives;
- Submission of proposals for the development of the Club;
- Representation of the Club in other organizations by decision of the Board.

### 3.4. Obligations of members of the Club:

- Compliance with the Charter;
- Respectful attitude towards other members;
- Participation in events and support of initiatives;
- Promotion of the Club's image and its international representation.

## 4. Governance Bodies of the Club

4.1. The highest governing body is the General Assembly of Members.

4.2. The current management is carried out by the Board of the Club.

4.3. The President of the Club is elected by the General Assembly.

## 5. Financing of Activities

5.1. The Club's activities are financed through membership fees, donations, sponsorship, and other sources not prohibited by law.

## 6. International Activities

6.1. The Club creates branches and partner communities in other countries for the development of international cooperation.

## 7. Charity

7.1. The Club supports charitable projects, including assistance to talented youth, support for education, culture, and healthcare.

## 8. Symbolism and Attributes

8.1. The Club has its own logo and attributes, approved by the Board.

## 9. Final Provisions

9.1. Amendments to this Charter are adopted by the General Assembly of the Club.

9.2. The Club operates indefinitely.
